

Year End Awards Program (YEAP) Packet Rider Achievement Awards

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Rules

Welcome to the Year-End Award Program (YEAP) of the Long Island Dressage Association (LIDA). If you have any questions or comments, please contact the designated YEAP Chairperson listed on the YEAP entry form, the website and in the LIDA Extension Newsletter.

To Submit in the Rider Achievement Awards of the YEAP:

- To qualify, rider must have been a member in good standing at the time when the score was earned.
- ➤ LIDA Medal Awards are based strictly on the scores the rider achieves over time, and need not be earned in one year. LIDA will accept scores for this category starting from the year 2015.
- ➤ Both Recognized scores and Schooling Show scores can be combined for these awards. Only scores earned in Dressage Seat Equitation classes are eligible.
- ➤ Western Dressage scores and Freestyle scores cannot be used.
- Scores may be earned at any Long Island Recognized Dressage Show or any Long Island Dressage Schooling show judged by an "L" graduate or higher.
- For the LIDA Dressage Medal Award, scores submitted do not have to be the highest test of the level.
- All award winners will be posted on the LIDA FaceBook page and the LIDA website prior to the Year-End Awards Dinner/Fundraiser. All awards will be distributed to recipients at that event.
- All YEAP applications and accompanying paperwork should be mailed to the LIDA address on the form and postmarked by the closing date on the website. All submissions must be accompanied by a copy of the rider's USDF scoresheet (no originals please), with the scores they would like to use circled. Applicants will receive an email from the YEAP Chairperson confirming receipt of paperwork.
- Applicants must indicate which award(s) they are competing for: JR/YR, AA or Open. A JR/YR is a member that has not reached 21 years of age as of January 1st of the current year. Adult riders must choose to ride either Open or Adult Amateur (AA). Members are only able to compete as Adult Amateurs beginning January 1st of the year in which they turn 22.
- ➤ No Combined Training dressage scores can be used towards any YEAP award.



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Dressage Seat Equitation Criteria

Elementary Level:

- Five (5) of your highest scores from three (3) different shows and three (3) different judges at one level (Training through Grand Prix).
- > Scores may be earned at any USDF/USEF Long Island recognized dressage show or any Long Island dressage schooling show judged by an "L" graduate or higher.
- ➤ All scores submitted must be at least 65%.

Accomplished Level:

- Five (5) of your highest scores from three (3) different shows and three (3) different judges at one level (Training through Grand Prix).
- > Scores may be earned at any USDF/USEF Long Island recognized dressage show or any Long Island dressage schooling show judged by an "L" graduate or higher.
- ➤ All scores submitted must be at least 70%.

Elite Level:

- Four (4) of your highest scores from three (3) different shows and three (3) different judges at one level (Training through Grand Prix).
- > Scores may be earned at any USDF/USEF Long Island recognized dressage show or any Long Island dressage schooling show judged by an "L" graduate or higher.

LIDA Dressage Medal Criteria

Starter Rider, Introductory Level, and Training Level:

- > Ten (10) of your highest scores.
- > Scores may be earned at any USDF/USEF Long Island recognized dressage show or any Long Island dressage schooling show judged by an "L" graduate or higher.
- > All scores submitted must be at least 60%.

First through Fourth Levels:

- Eight (8) of your highest scores.
- > Scores may be earned at any USDF/USEF Long Island recognized dressage show or any Long Island dressage schooling show judged by an "L" graduate or higher.
- > All scores submitted must be at least 60%.

Prix St. Georges and Intermediate Levels:

- > Six (6) of your highest scores.
- > Scores may be earned at any USDF/USEF Long Island recognized dressage show or any Long Island dressage schooling show judged by an "L" graduate or higher.
- > All scores submitted must be at least 60%.

Grand Prix:

- > Five (5) of your highest scores.
- > Scores may be earned at any USDF/USEF Long Island recognized dressage show or any Long Island dressage schooling show judged by an "L" graduate or higher.
- > All scores submitted must be at least 60%.
